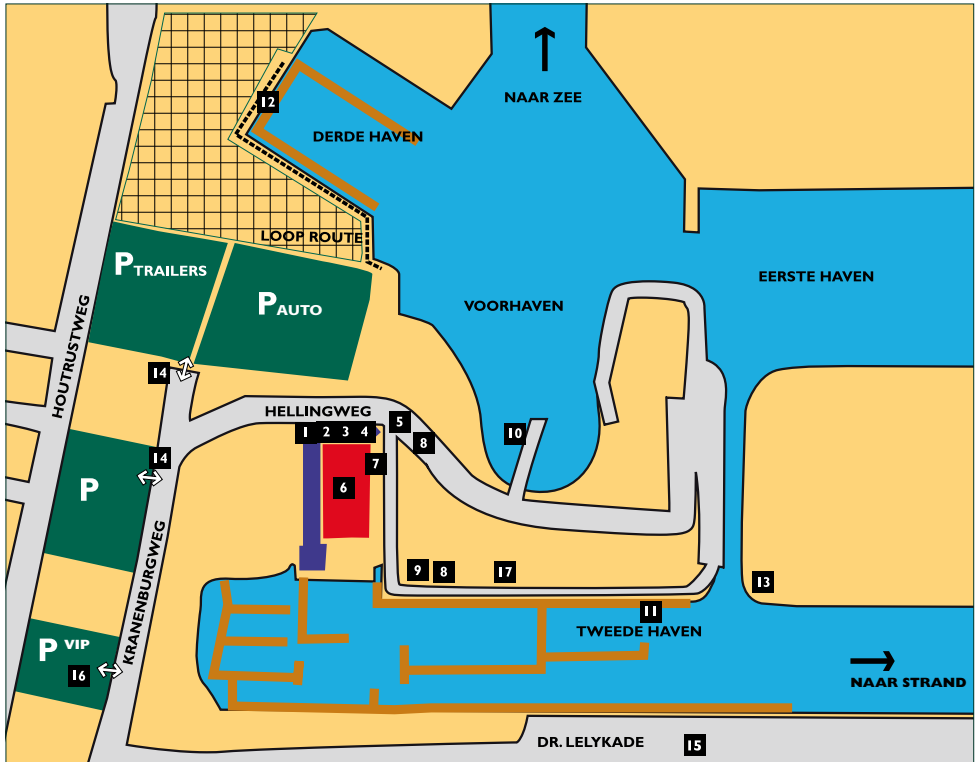

# General information

## Parking

The car park is located in the Norfolk area, at the end of Kranenburg road. Behind the Norfolk main port, VIP guests, participants and visitors can park their cars and trailers.

As every year, the Delta Lloyd North Sea Regatta Committee makes an urgent appeal to all participants to not park their cars in the streets around the port, but only in the car park in the Norfolk area. The end of the Hellingweg and the Regatta area itself are not accessible for cars, with the exception of the residents of the Hellingweg and local companies and suppliers. Also cars with trailers that need to use the ramp for launching their boats are allowed access, but they need a special pass for that. However, they may not park in this area. Participants can park in the Norfolk area for the whole weekend for € 10,-. Tickets can be bought from the parking attendants at the entrance of the Norfolk area. Catamaran sailors are advised to park near the beach, for example at the Visafslagweg (free parking).

## Parking

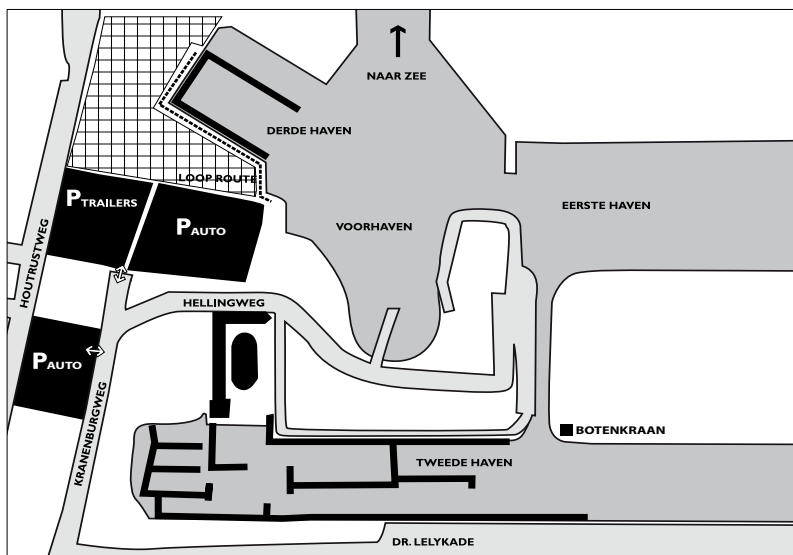
Around the harbour of Scheveningen only few parking spaces are available. This year, Saturday will be particularly crowded, due to a local festivity. Please drive to Scheveningen in groups and park only in the designated areas. These are the car park in the Norfolk area, at the end of Kranenburg road and the quayside at the Dr. Lelykade. You are kindly requested not to park in the streets around the port, to make sure the residents can still park their parks.

## Car parking participants

At the former Norfolk area participants can (see map). If your boat is docked in the temporary event port (third port) you can park near the port.

## Trailer parking

Trailer parking is available in the Norfolk area. There is a special area allocated for trailers (see map).



## **Campervan parking**

At the Norfolk area limited space is available for about 20 campervans. Only those who booked in advance can camp there.

Near the beach a small number of free parking spaces are available at the Visafslag (right behind the boulevard). On Saturday the area around the Visafslag will not be accessible, due to a local festivity. You are advised to park at the big, paid, parking lot next to the Northern pier (near the beach stadium). Catamaran sailors will also receive a parking ticket for the Norfolk area to come to the harbour in the evening.

## **Accessibility Hellingweg & Regatta area**

From Thursday morning the Hellingweg and the Regatta area will no longer be accessible for cars of participants. Only residents/local businesses can use the Hellingweg.

On Thursday and Friday morning participants of course E (small, open boats) can use the Hellingweg to bring their boats to the slipway. After that, they need drive their car and trailer to the Norfolk area as soon as possible.

## **Parking tickets**

Every team receives one personal parking ticket per entry via e-mail. The big boats (course A & B) receive two free parking tickets per boot. Other participants receive one free parking ticket per boat. If there is parking space available, extra parking tickets can be purchased at the entrance of car park for € 10,-.

## **Cranes**

As last year, the open keelboats will be craned at Dr. Lelykade (this is the second inner port), near the pipe. After craning, cars and trailers should be moved to the Norfolk area.

## **Berths**

The open keelboats can dock in the second port in the visitor marina on the side of the Nautical Centre. All yachts are given a place in the third port, which can be accessed **on foot** via the car park. Dinghies can be placed near the slipway at the Hellingweg. Catamarans are situated on the beach, near beach club Brunotti.

## **Camping/Campers**

Camping is no longer possible at the NSR area. Campervans are requested to go to F.A.S.T. (070-3586749) or holiday resort Kijkduin (+31 (0)70 - 448 21 00). On the Norfolk area a small number of campsites is available (no water or electricity). These need to be booked in advance via [info@nsr.nl](mailto:info@nsr.nl). Sites are allocated by booking date.

### **Delta Lloyd NSR-coin**

The currency during the North Sea Regatta is a Delta Lloyd NSR-coin. A Delta Lloyd NSR-coin represents a value of 2,50 euro (divisible) or 10 euro. You can use for buying drinks, snacks and meals. The Delta Lloyd NSR-coins can be bought at the information desk during the whole day. They are only valid during the Delta Lloyd North Sea Regatta 2011. The information desk is open up to an hour after the prize giving on Monday 24 May 2011. Be aware that only the 2011 coins are valid. Coins of previous years cannot be exchanged.

### **Wristbands**

Only participants and visitors with a valid wristband have access to the events area. Due to the exceptionally high standard of performances, there will be extra wristband checks this year.

### **Event area**

Every participant receives two wristbands (one extra) at registration in the Regatta Office.

### **The Regatta Shop**

The Delta Lloyd North Sea Regatta shop has a vast range of accessories and beautiful event clothing and is opened from Friday 10 June until Monday 13 June in the sailing village.

## **Toilets, showers**

Showers and toilet facilities are also situated at Hellingweg 136, first floor, opposite the Regatta Office. These facilities are closed from 23.00 to 08.00 hours. For 2,50 euro you can buy an electronic key at the Regatta Office, with which you can always access the facilities. on the event area, groups of chemical toilets are spread (see map).

## **Safes**

beside the Regatta Office at the first floor of Hellingweg 136 there are about 60 free safes.

## **First aid**

You can find the First Aid Post at Hellingweg136 and on the catamaran beach.

## **Port facilities**

During the Delta Lloyd North Sea Regatta you'll find our port masters in the port office on the first floor of Hellingweg 136 or in the Delta Lloyd NSR area.

## **Catering facilities**

Breakfast: From Saturday morning 11-13 June 2011, 07:00 till 09:30 hours at the NSR Breakfast shop (catered by Restaurant At Sea) you can buy a croissant, jus d'orange, boiled egg and a bun. Add a fresh cup of coffee and your meal is complete.

Lunchboxes: "Everyday something different, every day something nice" for lunch. 2 sandwiches, one piece of fruit, something sweet and one bun. You can order this in advance at the Breakfast/ontbijtshop.

Snacks: After 16:00 hours we'll sell for example hot dogs.

## **Dinner and drinks:**

We offer participants, their supporters and visitors a variety of culinary options. From Friday, tasty meals from several regions are available in the sailor village. To buy them, the Delta Lloyd NSR coin is required. In the restaurant you can pay with your credit or debit card.

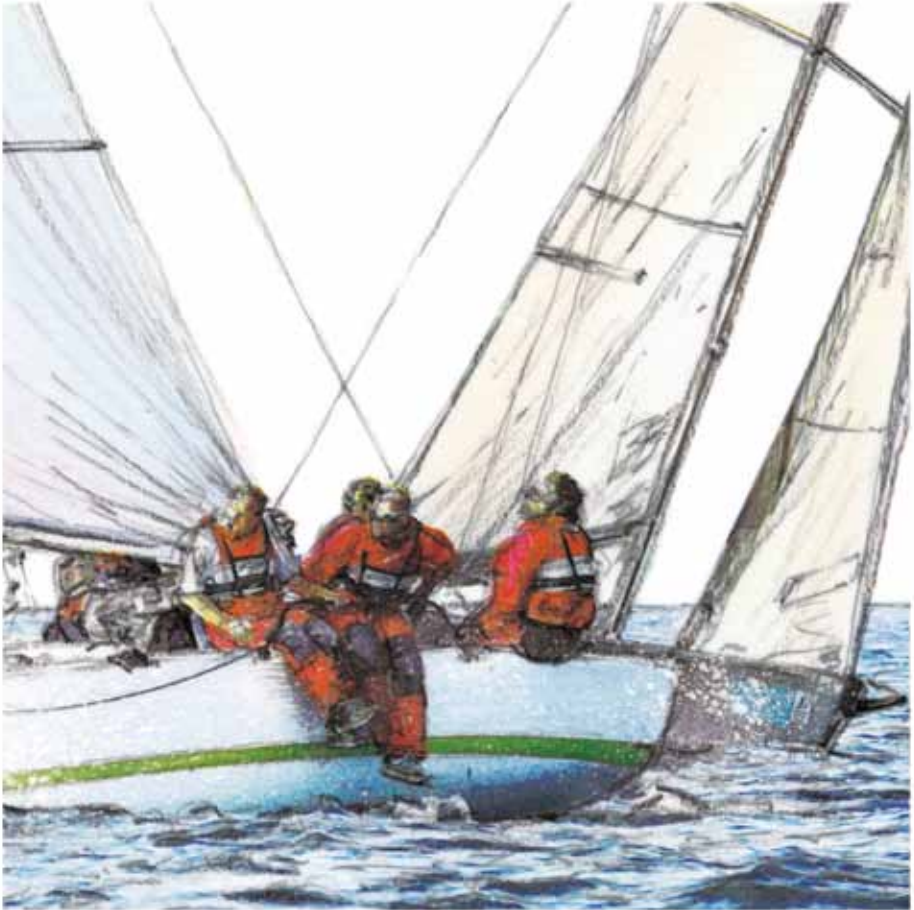
